This Call meeting of the Lake Park City Council was called to order at 7:00 pm on April 27, 2010 by Mayor Sandlin. Those present, Mayor Sandlin, members Carter, Mulkey, Schindler and Spradley, City Attorney, City clerk and interested citizens.

Ms. Tracey Vickers spoke with Council concerning activities for July 4<sup>th</sup> celebration. to run criminal/background checks on applicants. Chief Rutland will review all applications, working along with Mayor Sandlin, and have recommendation by May meeting.

Member Spradley moved City go into Executive Session to discuss Personnel matters, motion second by member Schindler, all approved. (7:20 pm). Meeting called back to order at 8:30 pm, with motion by member Spradley authorizing Mayor Sandlin to sign Affidavit and Resolution as to matters discussed in Executive Session, all approved.

Member Schindler moved Police Chief Bert Rutland be appointed to serve as Chief of Police until end of this Council term, motion second by member Spradley. When question called, members Carter, Schindler and Spradley for, member Mulkey abstained from voting, motion carries. Council advised Chief Rutland they wanted close communication with the department, and mentoring/training of all police employees.

Member Schindler stated the Council had agreed to allow Clerk one day of paid time off, in honor of Administrative Professional's Day.

There being no further business of this meeting, meeting was adjourned at 8:35 pm.
