STAFF REPORT File Number: LP-2018-1

Nature of the Request

The City of Lake Park is proposing to delete Article IV, Section 4-1.2 and amend Article IV, Section 4-1.3 Preliminary Plat Filing and Article IV, Section 4-2.6 Recording a Plat, of the City's Subdivision Regulations requiring that all plats, including preliminary plats and those requiring no new street, water, or sewer facilities, shall be brought before the City Council for their approval before said plats are submitted to the Planning Commission and that after the process of recording is complete, the recorded plat shall then be submitted to the City Council for their records.

Staff Analysis

Currently, the filing of a preliminary plat and recording of the final plat does not require action by the City Council. This text amendment will allow the City Council to know what parcels are being platted and recorded within the city.

Planning Staff Recommendation

Staff finds the request **consistent** with the purposes of the Subdivision Regulations and the City's mandate to protect the health, safety, and welfare of its residents, and recommends **approval** of the amendment to the Subdivision Regulations as it pertains to the filing of preliminary plats and final plat recording.
