Software Update: Lowndes County **IT Department** volunteered to let Lake Park use their services to update our Patrol Laptops with the new software at no cost to us. They currently have three of our Laptops, we should get them back by Monday next week.

The Director of IT advised we will get new Laptops, at no cost to us probably in July.

At the last meeting we discussed a "handshake" deal with the Sheriffs Office covering Lake Park when an Officer is not on duty. Sheriff Paulk stopped by and advised that the county lawyer thought a simple agreement should be signed. In the Scope of Service it mentions 1900-0700 hours, however, it's agreed that the County will cover just the hours when we are not on duty.

Both of our full time Officers (Benefield and Langley) are doing a fantastic job. Each bring bring a valuable unique skillset to the Police Department. There is money for a Sergeant position as discussed back in April at \$3/hour. At this time, I would like to give both Officers a raise using the \$3. I would like to promote Officer Langley to Sgt, he has over 30 years in L.E. and is an instructor for Firearms and other subjects. He is an excellent Traffic Officer making DUI cases etc to make our streets safer. Officer Benefield works traffic as well and has assisted in doing follow-up investigative work, which he is very detailed and thorough.

I would like to promote Officer Langley to a Sgt @ \$3more/hour and Officer Benefield to Officer/Investigator @ \$1more/hour.

Builder for O'Rileys called, store will not open until 08/03/2019.

I, along with Tabitha, had a couple of phone calls from residents that live on Golf Drive (outside the city) complaining that they don't like the fence that has been put up behind the U-Haul building. They don't like the barb wire and don't like looking at the U-Hauls, (Nothing requires the owner to put a fence up to begin with.... It's commercial property. If the council sees different please advise.

The City of Lake Park received a complainant from a citizen about a high intensity light from a neighbor that shines directly into the back windows of his home. Another neighbor near the complainant advised he gets the brunt of the light as well. The complainant further advised he believes that he is being harassed by signs in the offenders yard as well as the high intensity light. The only thing that I find in our ordinance that may be a law enforcement issue is the Disorderly Conduct law. One of the elements of

the law is "abusive conduct towards another". My plan is to contact the Offender(s) and ask them to redirect the light and remove a sign. If not, a citation will be issued and the court can rule on it. I share this because I understand this may be a sensitive issue for the city. I'm open for suggestions. le. Offical letter from City etc...

Insurance Stipend has been the same for over 10 years. Health Insurance has increased, however, the stipend has not. Not all employees will need GMA coverage if available. Please consider increasing the insurance stipend, if you can even find Gov't Insurance for \$150/month please advise.:)




