City of Lake Park Work Session Minutes April 26, 2021 6:00 PM

Mayor Pro Tem Ronald Carter called the work session to order. Those present were as follows; Council Members Tom Barr, Carl Taylor, and June Yeomans. Also present were Fire Chief David Brown, and Clerk Tabatha Fowler.

Mayor Pro Tem Carter called on Deb Cox, Lowndes County Supervisor of Elections, to come forward. Mrs. Cox provided updated qualifying and election calendars and answered questions from Council about polling places. No action taken.

Carter called for department reports;

Fire Chief David Brown came forward to give his monthly fire report, see report attached, no action taken.

Maintenance department report was reviewed by Council. Clerk Fowler stated that she had the number of additional benches and locations; one for the cemetery, four more at Tom's Pond, and two at the civic center. No action taken.

Police department report was reviewed by Council. Member Barr asked that the new police vehicle purchase be put on the agenda for May's Regular Meeting. No action taken.

Mayor Pro Tem Carter called for review of the business license requirements. Clerk Fowler started by explaining the correspondence from Attorney Plumb on how to handle those businesses that do not submit the required proof of gross receipts. A letter template was presented to Council and reviewed. Council agreed that letters should be sent certified mail and should go out as soon as possible. Member Yeomans stated that there should be an additional option of providing proof that a business applied for an extension on their taxes, and if that's the case then they would be allowed to use their previous year's gross receipts for the time being. Council also discussed food truck vendors and perhaps permitting them instead of requiring a business license, item to be put on next agenda to address. No action taken.

Carter called for review of the Grand Oak Village variance request. Clerk Fowler stated that the Board of Zoning Appeals would be meeting on Thursday April 29<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 to review the request for reduced front and rear yard setbacks. No action taken.

Mayor Pro Tem Carter called for review of the Cemetery survey update. No update to give at this time, no action taken.

Carter called for review of the July 4<sup>th</sup> Celebration. Member Taylor stated that he had been in contact with Clay Cothran regarding the purchase of fireworks and how much the city had allocated for the expense. No action taken.

Mayor Pro Tem Carter called for review of approved check signers. Member Taylor stated that he would like to establish some sort of schedule for expense checks to be issued and signed. He requested it to be added to the next agenda. No action taken at this time.

Executive/Admin Reports

Clerk Fowler asked Council if they had received any positive or negative feedback on the mosquito spraying. None was reported.

Clerk Fowler reported a situation regarding a water bill and the process that is taking place. The billing was explained and Fowler stated that there was no error found.
